

Post-Doctoral Programme Additional Information

The application may be made at any time and should be submitted at least 3 months before the desired start date.

The Post-Doctoral Programme has a minimum duration of 6 months and a maximum duration of 3 years.

The application form for admission to Post-Doctoral Programme, addressed to the President of the Scientific Council, should be complemented with:

- a) Work programme with the beginning and end date;
- b) Curriculum Vitae of the candidate;
- c) Copy of the Doctoral Degree Diploma;
- d) Statement of acceptance by the supervisor of the School of Sciences;
- e) Statement of agreement from the applicant's home institution, if applicable;
- f) Statement of agreement from the Research Centre of the School of Sciences where the Programme will take place.

The Post-Doctoral Programme implies the payment of an enrolment fee and an attendance fee, indexed to the number of months of duration of the training period.

The enrolment is made in the Academic Portal, within twenty days after the admission of the application, or until 5 days after the beginning of the programme, in this case upon approval by the Scientific Council of the School of Sciences.

At the end of the programme, within one month, a report must be submitted containing the scientific activities and the conclusions of the research carried out, the number and indication of the publications that resulted from it, as well as the statement of the supervisor, for approval by the Scientific Council of the School of Sciences.

The award of the Post-Doctoral Programme diploma depends on the presentation of the above-mentioned report, which is subject to the fees established in the current table of fees of UMinho.
